Professional Tractor Trailer Training Program Details:

160 hour course:

- 100 hours of coursework and classroom education;
 - Rules of the Road, Air Brakes, Pre-Trip Inspections, Accident Procedures, Cargo Documentation and Securement, Hours of Service Regulations, Driver Qualification Regulations, Defensive Driving, Backing and Loading Dock Procedures, Hazardous Materials Information, Indoor backing experience, and Simulator Training
- 60 Hours in a Class A Vehicle:
 - 30 hours hands-on backing maneuvers practice
 - 22 hours one-to-one instruction
 - Up to 8 hours reserved for testing+
- USDOT Drug Screen
- State administered Class A road test (up to 4 tests if needed)
- Objective: Prepare drivers for state administered Class A CDL road test, provides extensive training in large Class A vehicles after successfully passing road test in preparation for employment as professional driver
- Job Placement Assistance
- Course offered weekly
- Prerequisites:
 - Class D or higher grade license.
 - Must be able to pass Class A written exam
 - Must be able to pass USDOT drug screen
 - Per FMCSA 381.11.2, must be able to read and speak the English language sufficiently to converse with the general public, to understand highway traffic signs and signals in the English language, to respond to official inquiries, and to make entries on reports and records.

^Programs are to be paid on the first day of training to receive **Discount Price**. Driver training hourly rate is \$120.00 per hour with a two hour minimum. Training can be paid for daily at hourly rate. *Professional Tractor Trailer Pay as you Go Price: \$6,749.00. Accredited DOT required course must be paid in full in order to start training. Students must have passed a DOT drug screen within the last 30 days before any training can be scheduled. Authorization or Purchase Order must be received prior to training in order to bill for services and payment must be received within 10 days of receipt of invoice.
